The Millennium Challenge Corporation (“MCC”) and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia (the “Government”) have entered into a Compact for Millennium Challenge Account (“MCA”) assistance to help facilitate poverty reduction through economic growth in Indonesia (the “Compact”) in the amount of US\$ 600,000,000 (“MCC Funding”). The Government, acting through the Millennium Challenge Account - Indonesia (“MCA-Indonesia”), intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract for which this IFB is issued. Payment by MCC will be made only at the request of MCA-Indonesia and upon approval by MCC and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Compact, including restrictions on the use of MCC Funding and conditions to the disbursements.
2. The Compact Program includes five Components: a) the Green Prosperity Project (“GP”), b) the Community-based Health and Nutrition to Reduce Stunting Project, c) the Procurement Modernization Project, d) the Monitoring and Evaluation Component and e) the Program Administration and Control.
3. This Procurement falls under the GP Project. The Participatory Land Use Planning (PLUP) activity is being implemented through series of Participatory Mapping and Planning (PMaP) at various districts. MCA-Indonesia is seeking a Service Provider to provide the Internet Connection Service for several districts included in PMaP#3 activities.
4. This Invitation for Bidding (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice that appeared in dgMarket and the MCA-Indonesia website (<http://mca-indonesia.go.id/pengadaan/general-procurement-notice-period-january-march-2017/>)

on February 1, 2017 and UNDB online and in the local newspaper, Kompas, on February 3, 2017.

5. This Invitation for Bidding (IFB) is open to all eligible entities (“Bidders”) who wish to respond. Bidders may only associate with each other in the form of a joint venture or under a sub-contractual agreement to complement their respective areas of supply to enhance their capacity to carry out the services and so long as any association is formed or sub-contract is entered into in accordance with the bidding document associated with this IFB.
6. A Service Provider will be selected under the **Competitive Bidding (CB)** procurement method, the evaluation procedures for which is described in sections of the IFB in accordance with “MCC Program Procurement Guidelines” which are provided on the MCC website www.mcc.gov .
