This Request for Proposals (RFP) follows the General Procurement Notice that appeared in dgMarket and UNDB online advertised on February 1 and February 3, 2017 respectively, in local newspaper Kompas on February 3, 2017, and at the MCA-Indonesia website [http://www.mca-indonesia.go.id/en/procurements/general\\_procurement\\_notice/general\\_procurement\\_notice\\_period\\_january\\_march\\_2017-1054](http://www.mca-indonesia.go.id/en/procurements/general_procurement_notice/general_procurement_notice_period_january_march_2017-1054) on February 1, 2017.
2. The Request for Proposal (RFP) is open to all eligible entities ("Consultants") who wish to respond. Consultants may only associate with each other in the form of a joint venture or in a sub-consultancy agreement to complement their respective areas of expertise to enhance their capacity to successfully carry out the assignment and so long as any association is otherwise formed in accordance with the terms of the RFP.
3. A Consultant will be selected under the **Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS)** procurement method, the evaluation procedure for which is described in sections of the RFP in accordance with "MCC Program Procurement Guidelines" which are provided on the MCC website [www.mcc.gov](http://www.mcc.gov).
4. The Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC") and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia (the "Government" or "GoI") have entered into a Compact for Millennium Challenge Account ("MCA") assistance to help facilitate poverty reduction through economic growth in Indonesia (the "Compact") in the amount of US\$ 600,000,000 ("MCC Funding"). The Government, acting through the Millennium Challenge Account - Indonesia ("MCA-Indonesia"), intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Proposals is issued. Payment by MCC will be made only at the request of MCA-Indonesia and upon approval by MCC

and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Compact, including restrictions on the use of MCC Funding and conditions to the disbursements.

The Compact Program includes five Components: a) the Green Prosperity Project (“GP”), b) the Community-based Health and Nutrition to Reduce Stunting Project, c) the Procurement Modernization Project, d) the Monitoring and Evaluation Component and e) the Program Administration and Control. The provision of this procurement falls under the Green Prosperity Project.

Through this Request for Proposals, MCA-Indonesia seeks to support the peatland restoration activities in Indonesia by engaging consulting services to provide technical support support to Indonesia’s Peatland Restoration Agency (*Badan Restorasi Gambut, BRG*).

The technical assistance requirements include:

- Development and pilot implementation of a water table monitoring program for the Badan Restorasi Gambut (BRG). This will provide the baseline before and after the canal blocking to restore hydrological functions of the peatland; and
  - Generation of detailed engineering designs (DEDs), peatland mapping and inventory and obtaining free, prior, and informed consent (FPIC) for canal blocking dams at peatland landscapes.
