This Invitation for Bidding (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice that appeared in dgMarket, UNDB online and the MCA-Indonesia website (http://www.mca-indonesia.go.id/en/procurements/general_procurement_notice/general_procurement_notice_period_january_march_2017-105) on February 1, 2017 and in the local newspaper, Kompas, on February 3, 2017.
2. This Invitation for Bidding (IFB) is open to all eligible entities or persons (“Bidders”) who wish to respond. Bidders may only associate with each other in the form of a joint venture or under a sub-contractual agreement to complement their respective areas of supply to enhance their capacity to carry out the supply of goods and provision of required services and so long as any association is formed or sub-contract is entered into in accordance with the bidding document associated with this IFB.
3. A Supplier will be selected under a Competitive (CB) procurement method, the evaluation procedure for which is described in sections of the IFB in accordance with “MCC Program Procurement Guidelines” which are provided on the MCC website www.mcc.gov .

The Millennium Challenge Corporation (“MCC”) and the Government of Indonesia (the “Government” or “GoI”) have entered into a Millennium Challenge Compact for Millennium Challenge Account assistance to help facilitate poverty reduction through economic growth in **Indonesia** (the “Compact”) in the amount of approximately of US\$ 600,000,000 (“MCC Funding”). The Government, acting through the Millennium Challenge Account-Indonesia (“MCA Entity” or “MCA-Indonesia”), intends to apply a portion of the MCC Funding to eligible payments under a contract for which this Invitation for Bids (“IFB”) is issued. Any payments made under the proposed contract will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Compact and related documents, including restrictions on the use of MCC funding and conditions to the disbursements of MCC funding. No party other than the Government and MCA-Indonesia shall derive any rights from the Compact or have any claim to the proceeds of MCC Funding.

The Compact Program includes five Components: a) the Green Prosperity Project (“GP”), b) the Community-based Health and Nutrition to Reduce Stunting Project, c) the Procurement Modernization Project, d) the Monitoring and Evaluation Component and e) the Program Administration and Control.

The provision of this procurement falls under the Procurement Modernization Project.

In order to support the execution of LKPP’s LPSE Cloud strategy, MCA-Indonesia needs to acquire the additional hardware as specified in Section 6 Schedule of Requirements. The required hardware will be used to develop and transform the current system to be cloud ready, with the following features:

- WAN optimization Deployment.
 - FWaaS Deployment.
 - VPNaaS Deployment.
 - LbaaSv2 Deployment.
 - FSaaS Deployment.
 - Openstack Deployment Architecture and its advantages.
