1. This Request for Proposals (RFP) follows the General Procurement Notice that appeared in: dgMarket on August 11th, 2017; UNDB online on August 11th, 2017; MCA-Indonesia website http://www.mca-indonesia.go.id/id/procurements/general_procurement_notice/general_procurement_notice_period_june_december_2017-1197) on August 11th, 2017 and in the local newspaper, Kompas, on August 12th, 2017.
2. The Request for Proposal (RFP) is open to all eligible entities (“Consultants”) who wish to respond. Consultants may only associate with each other in the form of a joint venture or in a sub-consultancy agreement to complement their respective areas of expertise to enhance their capacity to successfully carry out the assignment and so long as any association is otherwise formed in accordance with the terms of the RFP.
3. A Consultant will be selected under the **Least Cost Selection (LCS)** procurement method, the evaluation procedure for which is described in sections of the RFP in accordance with “MCC Program Procurement Guidelines” which are provided on the MCC website www.mcc.gov.

The selection process, as described, will include a review of qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, and shall be subject to verification prior to the contract award.

4. The Millennium Challenge Corporation (“MCC”) and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia (the “Government” or “GoI”) have entered into a Compact for Millennium Challenge Account (“MCA”) assistance to help facilitate poverty reduction through economic growth in Indonesia (the “Compact”) in the amount of US\$ 600,000,000 (“MCC

Funding”). The Government, acting through the Millennium Challenge Account - Indonesia (“MCA-Indonesia”), intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Proposals is issued. Payment by MCC will be made only at the request of MCA-Indonesia and upon approval by MCC and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Compact, including restrictions on the use of MCC Funding and conditions to the disbursements.

The Compact Program includes five Components: a) the Green Prosperity Project (“GP”), b) the Community-based Health and Nutrition to Reduce Stunting Project, c) the Procurement Modernization Project, d) the Monitoring and Evaluation Component and e) the Program Administration and Control.

The provision of this procurement falls under the Monitoring and Evaluation Component.

The Scope of Services is comprised of three specific tasks as follows:

- Documenting and analyzing data collection, processing, analyzing and reporting processes employed by all the entities providing data to MCA-Indonesia to establish incidence of quality problems and detect low quality data;
- Formulating findings reflecting the results of the above task, including an overall assessment and rating of each dataset compared to international standards; and
- Developing recommendations (if applicable) on how to improve or enhance the quality of data.

5. With this invitation, MCA-Indonesia seeks to select a Consultant for the **Consulting Services for Data Quality Review for the Green Prosperity Project**.
6. Consultants interested in submitting a Proposal should register their interest by sending an e-mail, giving full contact details of the Consultant, in order to receive a copy of the complete RFP document.
